

## DANISH MUSLIM AID – PAKISTAN

# RELIEF HIGHLIGHTS

(September 07, 2010): Danish Muslim Aid (DM-Aid) has recently completed its first month of flood relief activities in Pakistan. Following are some of our **achievements**:

### **Medical Relief**

- 11 doctors have been engaged for immediate medical relief to flood victims
- 7 medical camps were arranged in District Charsadda and 3 UCs of District Noshehra
- 7 medical camps were arranged in different cities of Southern Punjab
- 7,000+ patients have been treated and provided free medicines so far

### **Food & Clean Drinking Water**

- 2600 families in Noshehra and Charsadda were provided food items
- 2600 families were provided mats, pillows, cotton sheets etc.
- Process of digging new wells (boring) at 3 different places has been initiated for provision of clean drinking water to three different localities.
- Already available water sources are being revamped.

### **Hygiene**

- Hired local labour and provided all necessary equipment to clean out the left-over of flood to avoid further diseases and Hygiene problems.
- Drainage system of Union Council Peer Sabaq of District Noshehra has been made functional.

### **Cash Grants**

- Cash grant has been given to more than 150 destitute families to fulfill their unmet daily needs.

### **Education**

- Constituted a committee of local primary school teachers and community members to reopen the schools to engage children in their education.

### **Counseling**

- Hygiene awareness sessions have been arranged and provided counseling to the victims to come out of trauma.
